

Submitting a Sixth Form application if your school have been unable to provide predicted grades

Predicted grades are the best way for us to make realistic Conditional Offers to our Sixth Form applicants, however we understand that this year a small number of schools have been unable to share formal predictions with their students (i.e. due to periods of isolation, school closure or lack of assessment practice).

Route A – Upload a Year 11 report

We are looking for grades that realistically reflect an applicant's academic performance. Therefore, where formal predicted grades are unavailable, we would ask applicants to instead enter 'working at' grades from their most recent Year 11 school report. These could be mock or PPE results, in-class assessment results or general 'working at' grades given by their subject teachers.

All grades entered on the application should be supported by an uploaded school report.

Route B – If no Year 11 Report is available

If no report is available from this academic year, then applicants should request a letter from their school to confirm that the applicant does not have recent official grades available, this letter should then be uploaded to the portal in place of a school report.

Applicants will also need to speak with their subject teachers to determine a realistic grade to enter on their application form for each subject.

Confirmation of grades

For all applicants, the grades entered onto the application form will be submitted to the named school referee for confirmation. At this point, the school will be given the opportunity to review, update or correct any grades that are inaccurate and will submit these final grades back to us.

Only grades that have been confirmed by the applicant's school will be used in the final assessment of the application.
