Weekly lessons

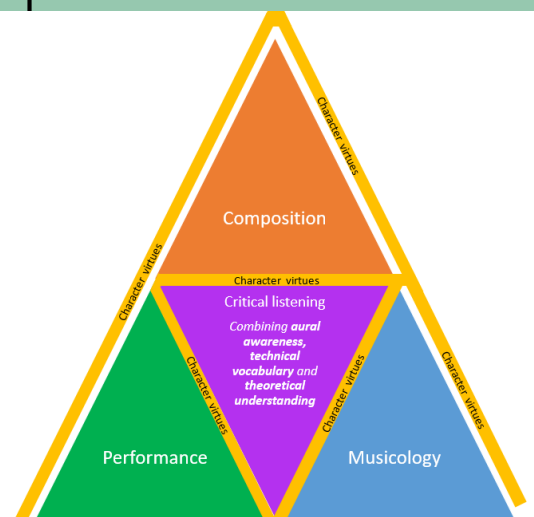
Music lessons are a central part of the UoBS KS3 curriculum. Students have 1-2 hours of music per week

Music for all

Our curriculum and teaching is designed to enable all students to flourish and achieve musically.

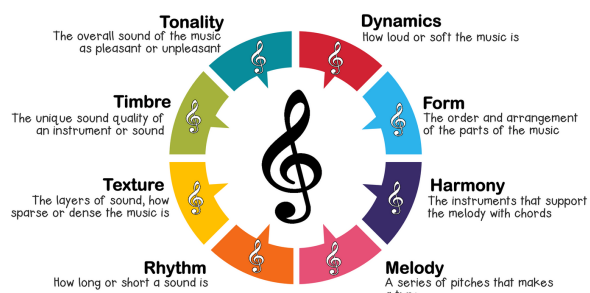


There are four central strands to the music curriculum; composition, performance, musicology (placing music in context) and critical listening, which combines theoretical and technical knowledge with listening skills.



Learning is sequenced so that students incrementally develop their understanding of how music works, through developing their understanding of the elements of music.

The 8 Elements of Music



Students make music in every lesson by playing and/or composing music. This involves gradual development of specific skills e.g. using music technology or playing guitar, alongside their developing knowledge of the elements of music.



Students complete regular music theory exercises and listening questions for home learning on our online classroom
