**Sixth Form students must wear**



**Suit jacket or blazer** - Suit style, smart and professional

**With**



**Shirt and tie**

Shirts must be tucked in and ties done up to the neck



**Blouse or smart business-style top**

Must cover shoulders

**And**



**Trousers**

No denim, no extra pockets, no leggings



**Skirt**

No denim



**Dress**

Must cover shoulders

**And**



**Shoes or boots** - Must be smart, no trainers or canvas (footwear such as black Nike Air Force or similar are not allowed)

**Optional**



**Jumper or cardigan** - Must be worn under a suit jacket or blazer

Not sweatshirt or sports style, no zips, no hoods

A School lanyard and ID card must be worn around the neck and visible at all times.

Jewellery should be discreet and kept to a minimum.

Any additional items of jewellery or clothing worn for religious reasons should be discussed with the School but reasonable requests will not be refused.

Outdoor wear, including coats, scarves, hats and caps are not allowed to be worn inside the School building.

The final decision on what is appropriate dress will rest with the Senior Management Team of the School. Any student who chooses to dress inappropriately may be asked to return home to change.
