# Homework Club



Homework is an important feature of supporting the learning of our pupils. Homework supports the learning taking place in lessons and helps consolidate class work. Homework can often help to ensure pupils are ready for their next lesson. The Education Endowment Foundation have conducted studies which show that homework has a significant positive impact on a child's education.

We recognise that many pupils can find organising and completing homework challenging. To support with this, we are introducing Homework Clubs to help support pupils and families with this.

**Please note, Homework Club is offered every day at the following times:**

## **Year 7, 8, 9 and 10:**

- Monday to Friday, from 08.00 – 08.45 in room G21. Your child should enter through main reception (front of the school building) and sign in at main reception. Your child must then stay for the duration of the study period until 08.45 - they will then be dismissed for the normal school day as usual. (Please note, pupils will not be able to join homework club after 08.20 in the morning).
- Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 15.45 - 16.30 in room G21. Your child will register in room G21 and is expected to stay for the duration of the study period until 16.30. Pupils will be dismissed through main reception (front of the school building) at 16.30.

## **Year 11:**

- Monday to Friday, from 08.00 – 08.45 in the atrium. Your child should enter through main reception (front of the school building) and sign in at main reception. Your child must then stay for the duration of the study period until 08.45 - they will then be dismissed for the normal school day as usual. (Please note, pupils will not be able to join homework club after 08.20 in the morning).
- Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 15.45 - 16.30 in room G21. Your child will register in room G21 and is expected to stay for the duration of the study period until 16.30. Pupils will be dismissed through main reception (front of the school building) at 16.30.
