Monday 08: Arts & Humanities Big Quiz. During the school day. Selected Year 9 pupils will attend a quiz at the University of Birmingham to broaden horizons and engage with students from the University.

Wednesday 10: UoBS On Tour in Oxford. Selected A level students will visit Oxford as part of 'UoBS On Tour', where Sixth Form students will have the choice to experience a day in Sheffield, Nottingham, Oxford, or Manchester - visiting accommodation, a university, and other landmarks.
