## ESSENTIAL



### Suit jacket or blazer must be worn by all students

Should be suit style & material

May be any single block colour  
(Black, Grey, Navy, Burgundy etc)

Subtle checks / pinstripes  
permitted

Size should allow for a jumper /  
cardigan to be worn underneath in  
cold weather



### Student ID Lanyard

Must be worn  
around the  
neck at all times



### Collared shirts with a top button must be worn with a tie

### Open-neck shirts / Blouses / Formal tops

Must cover shoulders and midriff

No logos, text or graphic prints.



### Formal trousers / skirt

No denim, no leggings

No extra pockets

### Formal dress

Plain in colour

Must cover shoulders



### Shoes or boots

Must be smart. No trainers, sports shoes or canvas  
(footwear such as black Nike Air Force or similar are not  
allowed)

## OPTIONAL



### Plain V-Neck / Cardigan

Worn beneath suit jacket or blazer  
No sweatshirts / hoodies / sports  
tops.

# SPORTS ENRICHMENT / A-LEVEL PE



## PE / Sport Enrichment

Appropriate sports / activewear

Plain in colour

No logos, text or graphic prints.

No sports bra-style tops

A Level PE students will be required to purchase branded UoBS PE tops, order details will be shared with students during the first few weeks.



Outdoor wear, including coats, scarves, hats and caps are not allowed to be worn inside the school building.

Plain / subtle jewellery is permitted (must be removed during sporting activities)

Any additional items of clothing or jewellery worn for religious reasons should be discussed with the Sixth Form Team, however reasonable requests will not be refused, providing students retain a smart, professional appearance. For safeguarding reasons full face coverings are not permitted.

The final decision on what is appropriate dress will rest with the Senior Leadership Team of the School.

Any student who chooses to dress inappropriately may be sanctioned and/or asked to return home to change.
